Uniform policy (effective August 2024)

At Rainbow, we believe that all our pupils should look smart and be proud of their school uniform. Our children and students represent the school at all times whilst out in the community, and through the school uniform they highlight our holistic and disciplined ethos.

Primary section	
EYFS to Year 2:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children to wear the RISU tie-dye shirts; • All children to wear dark blue shorts, trousers or skirt (as per school uniform shop) • Girls can wear the RISU tie-dye dresses instead of the above
Year 3 to Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children to wear the RISU tie-dye shirts • All children to wear dark blue shorts, trousers or skirt (as per school uniform shop)
Secondary section	
Year 7 to Year 11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All students to wear the RISU light blue shirt • All students to wear blue trousers or skirt (as per school uniform shop)
Year 12 and 13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All sixth form students to wear the RISU Yellow shirts • All sixth form students to wear black trousers or skirts (as per school uniform shop)
General points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All primary and secondary children/students should wear black shoes • NO flip-flops or canvas shoes (there should be no logos, only all black shoe) • Only official RISU pullovers/jumpers should be worn (as per the school uniform shop) • Simple ear studs are allowed for those with pierced ears • A single ring on a finger / single bracelet is allowed • Make up and nail varnish are not allowed at RISU • All longer hair must be tied back neatly • Hair length, natural or extensions must not exceed below waist length • Shirts in secondary should be tucked into the trousers/skirts at all times • Plain coloured belts to be worn around the trousers/ skirts • No elaborate or multi-coloured extensions are allowed • No elaborate styles or colours of haircuts are allowed (Mohawk / bright coloured dye) • Highlights in the hair are not allowed • Vests worn under school shirts should be plain white. No coloured vests or football shirts to be used as vests • Cultural garments – some students wear long sleeve tops, headscarves or leggings under the uniform. These should be navy blue in colour • No student should wear any additional scarves, hats or cover ups

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Socks should be plain white, navy blue or black (no other colour)
Physical Education / swimming lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All children / students to wear the official RISU PE kit (shirt and shorts in house colour). No other shirts or shorts are to be worn• All children / students to wear trainers for all PE lessons• All children / students to wear a black or navy blue swimming costume.
House events	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All children / students to wear the RISU official PE kit
School trips and sports events	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• When representing RISU at an inter-schools sports event, the RISU purple shirts must be worn to travel to and from the event. The appropriate team kit should be worn when competing• When on a school trip, the correct uniform as instructed by the trip leader should be worn
